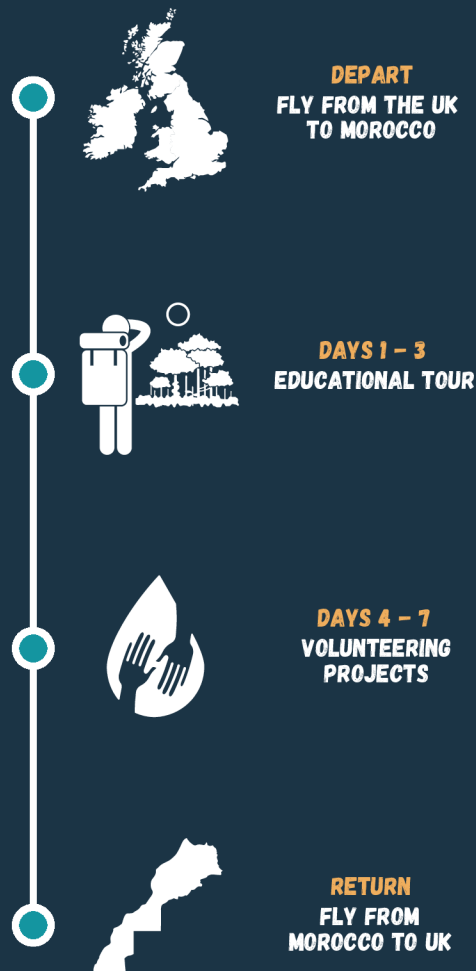

DAY 1

Exploring Marrakech



DAY 1 ACTIVITIES

Upon arrival at Marrakech Airport, the group will be welcomed by our in-country staff and transferred into the city.

Students will then enjoy a guided tour through the vibrant souks (markets) and historic palaces of the old medina, soaking in the sights, sounds, and culture of this iconic city.

The experience continues with a visit to the famous Jemaa el-Fnaa square –alive with storytellers, orange juice vendors, local performers, and views of the magnificent Koutoubia Mosque.

DAY 2 ACTIVITIES

After breakfast on the 2nd day, we drive through beautiful terrain to Ouarzazate, known as the gateway to the Sahara Desert featuring spectacular palaces and fortified cities.

Arriving in Ouarzazate, the group will tour the film sets of Atlas Studios where various films such as Black Hawk Down, Kingdom of Heaven and Gladiator I & II were filmed.

The group will also visit the Kasbah of Ait Benhaddou, a world heritage site and a prime example of an ancient fortified town. It also has been used in many films and series including Game of Thrones!

DAY 3

Camel Trek & Sandboarding





DAY 3 ACTIVITIES

Embark on a breathtaking journey through the Sahara Desert, trekking on camelback across sweeping sand dunes and passing small farms on the way to your campsite.

At the camp, students will get involved by helping to water and feed the camels, as well as assisting the cooks in preparing a delicious evening meal.

As the sun sets, enjoy the thrill of sandboarding down the dunes before settling in for an unforgettable night of wild camping under the stars.

Please note: During the summer months, camping is not possible due to extreme temperatures. In these cases, accommodation will be provided in a nearby villa.

DAY 4 – 5

Community Volunteering in the Mountains





DAY 4 - 5 ACTIVITIES

Over the course of two days, the group will volunteer in the mountain village of Telouet, working alongside and under the guidance of the local community.

Projects are based on the current needs of the village, but include:

- Agriculture – Digging new water channels to support local farming
- Classroom Revamp – Painting and refreshing school classrooms
- Infrastructure – Assisting with traditional mud-brick construction

This is a unique opportunity to make a meaningful contribution while gaining insight into rural Moroccan life and sustainable development practices.

**Donkey Rescue

DAY 6 ACTIVITIES

Students will spend the day volunteering at a local donkey rescue centre, helping to care for the animals by feeding, washing, and mucking out their pens. This is a truly inspiring charity that we proudly support—and a portion of your fundraising will go directly towards their work.

In the afternoon, the group will head to Terres d'Amanar, a stunning adventure park nestled in the forest. Here, students can take part in exciting activities such as ziplining and high ropes courses, surrounded by breathtaking natural scenery.

After an action-packed day, the group will return to Marrakech in the evening and chill out by the pool.

DAY 7 ACTIVITIES

On the final day, students will have some time to explore Jemaa el-Fnaa square for a bit of last-minute shopping—perfect for picking up souvenirs and gifts to take home to their families.

Afterwards, the group will travel to the airport with the Travelteer team, say their goodbyes to our wonderful Moroccan staff, and board their flight back to the UK.

On arrival in the UK, a pre-arranged coach will meet the group and return them to the original drop-off point, where parents will be waiting for collection.

ACCOMMODATION

TOURING THE COUNTRY

Whilst travelling around Morocco you will be staying at carefully selected hotels. These hotels are experienced in catering for school groups and have western amenities available – most importantly a swimming pool! The rooms are arranged in either twin or triple sharing (single gender) and each student has their own bed. Our Travelteer staff will always be on-site with the students for supervision. For one-night students will stay at our campsite where tents and sleeping mattresses will be provided.

VOLUNTEERING IN MOUNTAIN COMMUNITIES

During the two days of volunteering in the mountains, students will stay in a Gîte—a traditional, locally run hostel located in the heart of the village where the volunteer work takes place. The Gîte offers dormitory-style rooms with clean and comfortable facilities, including western-style amenities. While the accommodation is simple, it provides a warm and authentic experience of mountain life. Students will have their own dedicated area to relax, along with access to a beautiful balcony overlooking the mountains, making it a peaceful and memorable place to unwind after a day of volunteering.

LIVING ARRANGEMENTS

FOOD

All meals are included from the moment students land in Morocco until they reach the airport for their return journey. Travelteer provides three meals a day, ensuring students are well-nourished and have the chance to experience a variety of Moroccan and international dishes.

BREAKFAST

Each morning, students will be served breakfast—whether at the Gîte in the mountains or one of our selected hotels during the tour. A continental-style breakfast is always available, including options such as cereal, eggs, fruit, and toast. There will also be opportunities to try a traditional Moroccan breakfast, offering a unique taste of the local culture.

LUNCH/DINNER

Students will enjoy a wide range of Moroccan delicacies, including popular dishes like tagine and couscous, as well as familiar Western options. When staying at the Gîte or camping, our on-site chefs will prepare fresh lunches and dinners for the group. We can easily cater for any dietary requirements or allergies—please ensure we're informed in advance so we can accommodate all needs.

LIVING ARRANGEMENTS

TRANSPORT

At Travelteer, safety and comfort are our top priorities. We work with a trusted in-country transport provider that upholds high vehicle standards and ensures regular maintenance of all vehicles.

Throughout the trip, students will travel in 18-seater Mercedes minibuses equipped with air conditioning and panoramic windows, allowing them to relax and enjoy the stunning Moroccan landscapes in comfort.

FUNDRAISING

HOW MUCH SHOULD I RAISE?

We require each student to fundraise a minimum of £100. The funds raised go directly to support our programmes, making a huge impact on local communities. These funds help us purchase equipment and further develop our initiatives.

FLIGHT REIMBURSEMENT

Students are entitled to put any money over the required fundraising threshold of £100 towards the travel cost of their return flight. This will be reimbursed once the fundraising period has ended. Any surplus money exceeding the cost of your flight will be donated to Travelteer Impact to further our charitable causes!

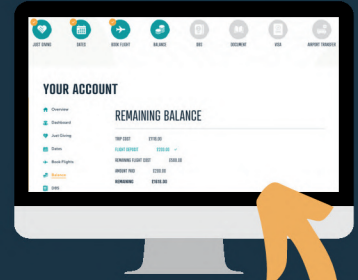


NEED IDEAS?
