

WHAT'S INCLUDED

ACCOMMODATION

We know living space is important! That's why we aim to blend cultural experiences, comfort and a great social scene all under one roof. We have three types of accommodation which vary depending on your group size and location.



SRI LANKA

Our two week School Trip in Sri Lanka is split into a single week of travel (our Coast 2 Coast Tour) followed by a week of high impact volunteering in our base of Hikkaduwa.

COAST 2 COAST TOUR ACCOMMODATION

Each day brings something new and exciting on our Coast 2 Coast tour, and with it a new place to stay for each night!

The accommodation varies throughout the country, but each property has been hand picked by the Travelteer team for comfort and security. Rooms are always single sex and are generally dorm style bedrooms with bunkbeds, though there will occasionally be twin bed options. All students will be kept under the close supervision of the Travelteer Staff.



SOCIAL & EATING AREAS

All accommodation during the tour will have ample room for social activities where the students can hang out with their friends. All meals are provided, whether that be at that night's accommodation for dinner, or at select local restaurants during the day when travelling.

HIKKADUWA ACCOMMODATION

After students have finished their first week of touring the country's highlights, they will arrive in the South-west of the island and get settled in to their accommodation in Hikkaduwa - their base for the next week! The following two accommodation options will be based on the school group size.

TRAVELTEER HOUSE (HIKKADUWA)

The TRAVELTEER favourite! This set-up ticks all the boxes for school trips. Just a stone's throw to the beach, this complex comes with loads of social space and a roof top eating area.

THE ROOMS

Travelteer House can accommodate up to 36 students, with single sex dormitories lodging up to six volunteers per room. Two UK Travelteer Staff (one male, one female) will sleep on-site for support. Volunteers are provided with clean bedding and all rooms are fitted with fans and mosquito nets!

Every room has an en-suite bathroom consisting of a western style toilet, shower and sink. Each volunteer has room for storage and we provide personal lockers for valuable items. Our female cleaning staff clean the rooms daily and change the bedding weekly!



SOCIAL & EATING AREAS

The Travelteer House has two common rooms (with WIFI access), along with a volunteer kitchen and a large veranda. Our rooftop level can hold up to 50 people and has long dining tables for communal meals. All volunteer meals are served here and it is often used for social events and group meetings.

Filtered water is complementary and a small amount of soft drinks can be purchased on-site! We use an external laundrette to provide a laundry service if your group needs clothes washed.



THE LAKEHOUSE (HIKKADUWA)

If you are a smaller school group, then the Lakehouse may be of interest! This property is a small boutique hotel set on the palm fringed edges of Hikkaduwa Lake. Please note that this property is subject to availability, so if this sounds of interest please get in touch with the Travelteer Team to discuss options!

THE ROOMS

The Lakehouse boutique hotel has 6 rooms that can be made up with twin beds. Each room features an en-suite bathroom with a shower, sink and western style toilet.

The rooms also feature a private balcony and full access to the crystal clear waters of Hikkaduwa Lake. Students staying at this accomodation will be served the same food as they would have at the Travelteer House.



SOCIAL & EATING AREAS

For school groups staying at the Lakehouse, all meals will be served in our beautiful pavilion that overlooks Hikkaduwa Lake. The menu is exactly the same as that of the Travelteer House and we can of course accomodate any dietary requirements.

Evening activities such as game and quiz nights will be held in the lakeside pavilion and students will be able to relax and swim in the crystal clear lake between projects during the week. As with the Travelteer House, two Travelteer Staff (one male, one female) will stay on-site for security and support.



NEPAL

Our two week School Trip in Nepal is split into a single week of travel (our Peak 2 Peak Tour) followed by a week of high impact volunteering in our base of Pokhara. Throughout the Nepal experience, students will be blown away by the beauty of the country and our accommodation options let them experience this new world in a relaxed, comfortable environment.

PEAK 2 PEAK TOUR ACCOMMODATION

During our Peak 2 Peak Tour through the incredible landscapes of Nepal, school groups will stay in various small, boutique hotels that have been carefully selected by the Travelteer team.

The accommodation varies throughout the country, but rooms are always single sex and generally set up with two - four people per room. All of these small hotels feature western amenities with showers, western style toilets and mosquito nets (where needed!). Our Travelteer staff will always be on-site with the students for supervision.



VOLUNTEERING ACCOMMODATION

After a week of travel, the school group will set up their base in Pokhara and kick-off their week volunteering! For the majority of this week they will stay in a small hotel on the edges of beautiful Pokhara Lake, again will full western amenities and all meals provided. The hotel has been selected by Travelteer staff for its comfort and security and is a great base from which to volunteer

The group will also have the amazing experience of staying one night in a home-stay, giving an amazing insight into the lives of those living in mountain communities.

MEALS

Throughout the School Trip's two week experience, all days but one will have three meals provided and are usually a mix of both traditional local cuisine and western alternatives! The remaining day is an Activity Day where volunteers can decide where they would like to eat with guidance from the Travelteer Team. SECURITY

We take Volunteer safety and security of personal belongings very seriously!
