

WHAT'S INCLUDED

ACCOMMODATION

We know living space is important! That's why we aim to blend cultural experiences, comfort and a great social scene all under one roof. We have three types of accommodation, which vary depending on your programme, location and budget!



TRAVELTEER HOUSE (SRI LANKA)

The TRAVELTEER favourite! This set-up ticks all the boxes for young travellers. Just a stone's throw to the beach, this complex comes with loads of social space and a roof top eating area.

THE ROOMS

Travelteer House can accommodate up to 36 volunteers, with single sex dormitories lodging up to six volunteers per room. Volunteers are provided with clean bedding and all rooms are fitted with fans and mosquito nets!

Every room has an en-suite bathroom consisting of a western style toilet, shower and sink. Each volunteer has room for storage and we provide personal lockers for valuable items. Our female cleaning staff clean the rooms daily and change the bedding weekly!



SOCIAL & EATING AREAS

The Travelteer House has two common rooms (with WIFI access), along with a volunteer kitchen and a large veranda. Our rooftop level can hold up to 50 people and has long dining tables for communal meals. All volunteer meals are served here and it is often used for social events and group meetings.

Filtered water is complementary and a small amount of soft drinks can be purchased on-site! We use an external laundrette to provide a laundry service if you wish to get your clothes washed.



THE LAKEHOUSE (SRI LANKA)

If you are a couple or wish to have your own private room, you can upgrade to our other accommodation located on the edges of Hikkaduwa Lake. This property is a small boutique hotel but we are happy to offer accommodation rates of just £20/day (compared to £10/day at Travelteer House). Please note that this is subject to availability, so if this sounds of interest please get in touch with the Travelteer Team to discuss options!

THE ROOMS

The Lakehouse boutique hotel has 6 rooms that can be made up with either double or twin beds. Each room features an en-suite bathroom with a shower, sink and western style toilet.

The rooms also feature a private balcony and full access to the crystal clear waters of Hikkaduwa Lake. Volunteers staying at this accommodation will be served the same menu as those at the Travelteer House.



SOCIAL & EATING AREAS

For those volunteers staying at the Lakehouse, all meals will be served in our beautiful pavilion that overlooks Hikkaduwa Lake. The menu is exactly the same as that of the Travelteer House and of course we can accommodate dietary requirements..

This property has a much quieter feel to it than the Travelteer House, perfect for those looking for a bit of privacy and quiet. All social events will be held at the Travelteer House, just a short Tuk-Tuk ride away. The Lakehouse features a volunteer kitchen and evening activities such as Yoga sessions can be organised for volunteers at an additional cost.



ACCOMMODATION IN NEPAL

Volunteers will be based out of the Travelteer House on the edges of Pokhara Lake during the weekends and whilst volunteering on our Pokhara based projects. As our community development programme also works with various mountain communities, we have hand selected a number of home-stays (staying with local families) throughout the region during projects that are based further afield.

TRAVELTEER HOUSE (POKHARA)

Nestled on the edges of beautiful Pokhara Lake, the Travelteer House can hold up to 20 volunteers. The accommodation is made up of single sex dormitories and each room is fan cooled and fitted with mosquito nets (where needed!). Volunteers will have access to full western amenities with western style toilets and showers as well as being provided with fresh bedding upon arrival. We have staff that clean the rooms daily and change bedding weekly. Private lockers are also provided for volunteer's valuables.

If you are a couple or wish to have a private room, please contact the Travelteer team to discuss options, please note there will be an extra charge involved.



HAND SELECTED HOME-STAYS

All of our Home-stays have been hand selected and vetted by the Travelteer team and they offer an amazing insight into the lives of local mountain communities! Volunteers will stay in these properties as a group, so you will always be surrounded by new friends! All meals will be provided by the host families and purified water is readily available.

Please note that CCTV is not in operation at the homes of local families, but they are very secure and a Travelteer co-ordinator will always be staying alongside the volunteers.

MEALS

From Monday - Friday, three meals a day are included in each volunteering scheme! On the weekends we provide breakfast, but volunteers need to buy their lunch and dinner - this is a great way to get out and explore the surrounding area! SECURITY

We take Volunteer safety and security of personal belongings very seriously! Sri Lanka and Nepal are very safe destinations, but for added precaution our accommodation options are gated and fitted with CCTV.
